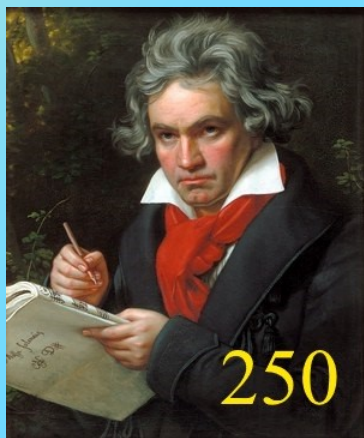

Beethoven unpacked, revealed, undressed – you name it, our fantastic Music Director, Robin Browning, explains why Beethoven is the icon he is and why he still has this status even in the 250th anniversary year of his birth.

The dramatic overture "Coriolan" will open the programme. Then Robin will take HCO – and you! – on an exploration of the great master's "Pastoral" Symphony, illustrated by orchestral excerpts and concluding with a full performance.

Wickham Community Centre is on the northern edge of Wickham and was completed in 1988 as a purpose-built community centre for the Wickham area.

By car, it is 10 minutes drive north from the Fareham area, up the A32 Wickham Road to the junction with Southwick Road (B2177) then turn left under the bridge into Bridge Street and right into Mill Lane. The Centre is on the left about a quarter of a mile up the road, at the entrance to Houghton Way. From the Havant direction, you can join the A32 via M27 junction 10 (the next one after the Fareham and Gosport exit). There is free car parking in front of the building and additional space behind it.
