He also started the Bob Harding Bursary for student conductors and we are delighted that two alumni of that scheme, Mark Wigglesworth and Toby Purser, wanted to show their appreciation by returning to conduct this concert. Also conducting will be the current holder of the bursary, Stefano Boccacci.

Many past members of both our orchestras have been invited back to join us. The music reflects favourite composers of Peter's, popular classical works and a piece that Peter was instrumental in bringing to life .

Peter always supported young local musicians so it is fitting that we are able to enjoy the playing of cellist Richard Harwood, who comes from Waterlooville and now enjoys an international career as a solo cellist and principal cello with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra. Richard will be joined by friend and colleague, leader of the RPO, Duncan Riddell.
