Havant Symphony Orchestra (HSO) concerts are at **Oaklands Catholic School** in **Waterlooville**, which is fortunate to have the best hall in the area for large orchestral concerts, with raked seating and excellent acoustics.

HSO has three new soloists this season: **Matilda Lloyd**, trumpet (winner of 2014 BBC Young Musician Brass final), pianist **Christos Fountos** and international violinist **Melina Mandozzi**. HSO's first concert was in July 1962, so the July concert is a **60th Anniversary** celebration.

Ferneham Hall has closed for refurbishment so **Havant Chamber Orchestra** (HCO) will be performing at **Holy Trinity Church** on West Street, Fareham, in order to remain convenient for existing audience members.

The first concert is dedicated to HCO's memories of **Brian Howells**, HCO leader from 1997 to 2020, as a celebration of his huge contribution to the orchestra, sadly cut short by Covid-19 in April 2020. The selected works are for strings only or for small classical orchestra, and feature young soloists **Laura Rickard** (previously leader of Hampshire County Youth Orchestra) and **Elliott Perks** in Mozart's Sinfonia Concertante for violin and viola.

The second concert has a French theme and features talented Russian cellist **Mikhail Lezdkan** returning by popular request, this time to perform the Saint-Saëns concerto.

The final concert consists of major works by the German giants Beethoven, Brahms and Mendelssohn, with rising star violinist **Charlotte Saluste-Bridoux** playing the Brahms concerto.

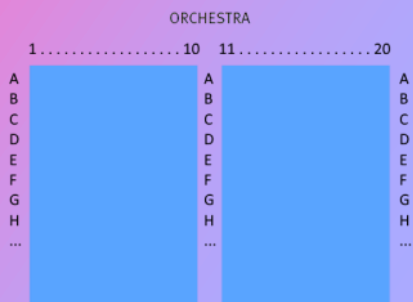

Seating plan for Holy Trinity Church



Seat numbers read from left to right. All seats are on the flat and have the same price.

In Holy Trinity Church the seats are wooden pews, so we suggest taking a cushion for comfort. There are side aisles between seats 5/6 and 15/16. Seats 1 and 20 are unused to leave more space. There are 12 rows, A to L, in the central section and eight rows, A to H, on either side. Seats 6 and 15 in some rows (D, H and L) are occupied by pillars.

Seat numbers read from right to left. Within each row of the tiered seating, to provide more space, seat numbers 1, 13, 20 and 32 are not used.

Section Z is on the flat but has steps down to it. Disabled seating on the balcony with flat access is limited. Please indicate if required.

Tickets for individual concerts

These go on sale two to three months before each concert. They may also be available at the door, but for the HCO concerts at Holy Trinity Church the seating capacity is very limited so there is a risk that tickets may be sold out. To avoid queues and have the best choice of seats it is best to buy tickets well in advance, either online via **TicketSource** (see the **Tickets** page on the Havant Orchestras website for details) or from the Tickets Secretary as above. You can also book tickets by phone via **TicketSource** on **03336 663366** for which there is an additional booking fee, currently **£1.80** at the time of printing.
